OML FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The OML Fellowship Program is a flagship project of NELIS – Next Leaders' Initiative for Sustainability. It operates in four regions: Africa, Asia, Latin America, and MENA (Middle East and North Africa) since 2022.

The Fellowship Program aims to equip one million NexGen leaders and social innovators with the required skills to lead positive and sustainable change in their regions by 2030.

In 2024, our aim is to train and empower at least 7500 leaders in the four regions and support the implementation of more than 100 community projects.

The OML Fellowship Program annually awards the OML Fellowship to passionate youth from the four regions.



OML VISION

One World in Harmony



To connect, inspire, and empower one million young sustainability leaders by 2030.

OML MISSION

OML exists to create a vibrant, local2global, action-focused network of NexGen leaders for sustainable and lasting change across Africa, Asia, Latin America, and MENA.

OML FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM PHASES



FELLOWS' INTENSIVE TRAINING

Fellows' Intensive Training is the first phase, where selected young leaders receive intensive training based on the five pillars of the OML Fellowship Curriculum. These selected young leaders are referred to as Fellows.



LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE

Fellows take on a leadership challenge to connect, inspire, and empower young leaders in their communities as they pass on their learnings and build a team. We call this second tier of young leaders Champions, and each Fellow is expected to build a team of at least 20 Champions (50 in OMLA).

In this phase, Fellows will also be provided with a series of Masterclasses on key sustainability topics, while they lead the training with their Champions.



ACT-FOR-CHANGE

Fellows enter into a project implementation phase in collaboration with the team they built in Phase 2. Based on a rigorous screening process, selected fellows will be able to do their own projects to innovate around key sustainability challenges in their communities with a micro-grant from NELIS.

Fellows may propose themes based on what they perceive to be key social and environmental challenges in their community or country.




GRADUATION AND OML ALUMNI COMMUNITY

OML CURRICULUM PILLARS




Five Curriculum Pillars of OML Fellowship Program

OML Fellowship Program Timeline

The OML Fellowship Program begins in January and ends in August/September and runs in the four main phases mentioned above.



Who is an OML Leader?

An OML Leader is a youth who has a burning passion to create a significant and positive impact in their community; who is willing to learn the required skills and tools to make this positive change happen; who desires to inspire and empower other youths, and who is eager to join a global network of changemakers.

Our Expectations of Fellows and Champions

1. Acquiring Essential Skills

Willingness to learn the necessary skills and tools to lead and help implement positive change.

2. Local and Global Collaboration

Eagerness to empower others and to join a global network of changemakers committed to driving positive impact worldwide.

We equip OML leaders with leadership literacy, knowledge, tools, and skills thus guiding them towards ethical and sustainable problem-solving methods.

2. Transformational Journey

Our program is designed to catalyze a transformative change in the habits, thoughts, and actions of the participating Fellows and Champions.

While we aim to create global impact by empowering One Million Leaders, our primary focus is on the quality of the change we enable.

2. Mindset Change

The core of our mission is to shift mindsets, empowering leaders to create ripple effects that inspire and mobilize other youths in their communities to become leaders and changemakers.

Application

The application form must be duly filled in. All fields must be filled in unless there is an option.

Initial Screening

The application form will be reviewed. If all fields are duly filled in and the criteria match, applicants will be selected for the next stage.

Detailed Evaluation

The applications that pass the initial screening will go for detailed evaluation. All the initially screened applications will be evaluated against the same evaluation criteria. Applicants who pass this phase will be invited to an interview.

Interview

Selected candidates will be asked to participate in an online interview.

Final Selection

100 fellows will be selected for the 2024 cohort of the OML Fellowship Program from each region (Asia, Africa, MENA, and Latin America). Final selection and announcement will be made by 20th February by the respective OML Secretariats in Africa (Nigeria), Asia (Nepal), Latin America (Colombia), and MENA (Jordan).

Leave no one behind

We believe in the potential of all youth to become changemakers. Therefore, applicants who are initially screened, but not selected as Fellows, will be provided an opportunity for training on the OML Curriculum Pillars through a short-term training curriculum called OML Lite. OML Lite participants who have successfully completed this program will also be awarded a certificate and can apply to join the next cohort of the OML Fellowship Program.

OML Fellowship Cascade Model

The OML Fellowship Program is based on a unique cascading model that aims to connect and empower a large number of young leaders in each region, with two tiers of leaders – Fellows and Champions. As part of their Leadership Challenge, each of the 100 Fellows connect and empower at least 20 Champions (in OMLA, 50) from their community or country.

Our goal for 2024

"To graduate at least 7500 leaders and support at least 100 community projects worldwide"

1 Fellow engages 20 Champions (50 in OMLA)

100 Fellows => 2000 Champions (5000 in OMLA)

Total OML leaders in one OML region: 2100 (5100 in OMLA)

Additionally, we expect several hundred OML Lite participants to join the online-only training curriculum.

Total for all four regions

400 Fellows (100 Fellows in each region) 11000 Champions (5000 Champions in OMLA and 2000 in other 3 regions)

Total OML leaders from 2024 OML Fellowship Cohort = 11400 plus OML Lite participants. Of these, it is our aim to graduate a minimum of 7500 leaders in 2024.

Community Projects

The community project implementation gives Fellows an opportunity to work with the Champions to engage in real-world sustainability challenges in their communities.

It is our aim to support at least **100 community projects** across the four regions in 2024. Projects deemed to be of the required quality will be supported with a microgrant to help kick-start the project.



Future Opportunities for Champions and OML Lite Participants

- OML Champions may join the global OML Alumni Community and apply for the full OML Fellowship Program 2025.
- OML Lite participants, upon completion of their training, may also apply for the OML Fellowship Program 2025.
