OML FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The OML Fellowship Program is a flagship project of NELIS – Next Leaders’ Initiative for Sustainability. It operates in four regions: Africa, Asia, Latin America, and MENA (Middle East and North Africa) since 2022.

The Fellowship Program aims to equip one million NexGen leaders and social innovators with the required skills to lead positive and sustainable change in their regions by 2030.

In 2025, our aim is to train and empower at least 8400 leaders in the four regions.

The OML Fellowship Program annually awards the OML Fellowship to passionate youth from the four regions.



OML VISION

One World in Harmony

To connect, inspire, and empower one million young leaders by 2030 through sustainability.



OML MISSION

OML exists to create a vibrant, local2global, action-focused network of NexGen leaders for sustainable and positive change across Africa, Asia, Latin America, and MENA.



Who is an OML Leader?

An OML Leader is a youth who has a burning passion to create a significant and positive impact in their community; who is willing to learn the required skills and tools to make this positive change happen; who desires to inspire and empower other youths, and who is eager to join a global network of changemakers.

Our Expectations of Fellows and Champions

1. Commitment and Passion in acquiring essential skills and knowledge

Willingness to learn the necessary skills and tools to lead and implement positive change.

2. Local2Global Collaboration and community building

Eagerness to empower Champions and to join a global network of changemakers committed to driving positive impact where most needed.

Our Approach

1. Holistic Empowerment

We equip OML leaders with leadership skills, knowledge, and tools thus guiding them towards ethical and sustainable problem-solving methods.

2. Transformational Journey

Our program is designed to catalyse a transformative change in the habits, thoughts, and actions of the participating Fellows and Champions.

Our Focus

1. Quality

While we aim to create global impact by empowering One Million Leaders, our primary focus is on the quality of the change we enable.

2. Mindset Change

The core of our mission is to shift mindsets, empowering leaders to create ripple effects that inspire and mobilize other youths in their communities to become leaders and changemakers.

One Million Leaders Asia (OMLAS) Fellowship Program

OMLAS Fellowship Program is a flagship program of NELIS Global in the Asia region. This Program has started since 2022. In the first cohort, 18 Fellows and 630 Champions graduated in 2023. In the second cohort, 97 Fellows and 1450 Champions graduated in 2024.

The Program is run by OMLAS Secretariat in Kathmandu Nepal

OMLAS (One Million Leaders Asia) FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM PHASES

PHASE

1

FELLOWS' INTENSIVE TRAINING

Fellows' Intensive Training is the first phase, where selected young leaders receive intensive training based on the five pillars of the OML Fellowship Curriculum. These selected young leaders are referred to as Fellows. There will be two to three live virtual sessions in the evening of every week in this phase.

PHASE

2

LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE

Fellows take on a leadership challenge to connect, inspire, and empower young leaders in their communities as they pass on their learning and build a team. We call this second tier of young leaders Champions, and each Fellow is expected to build a team of at least 20 Champions in their communities and networks..

In this phase, OMLAS Secretariat will provide sessions on five pillars. Then, Fellows have a choice to collaborate with other Fellows to train Champions or do it independently. Each Champion after the training phase must go through assessment to be eligible for OML Leader recognition and certificate.

PHASE

3

ACT-FOR CHANGE/ OML Summit

In October (17-19) 2025, Fellows and Champions will participate in virtual as well as physical (hybrid) OML Summit.

Fellows who are interested to do projects are encouraged to find their own funding to implement the projects.

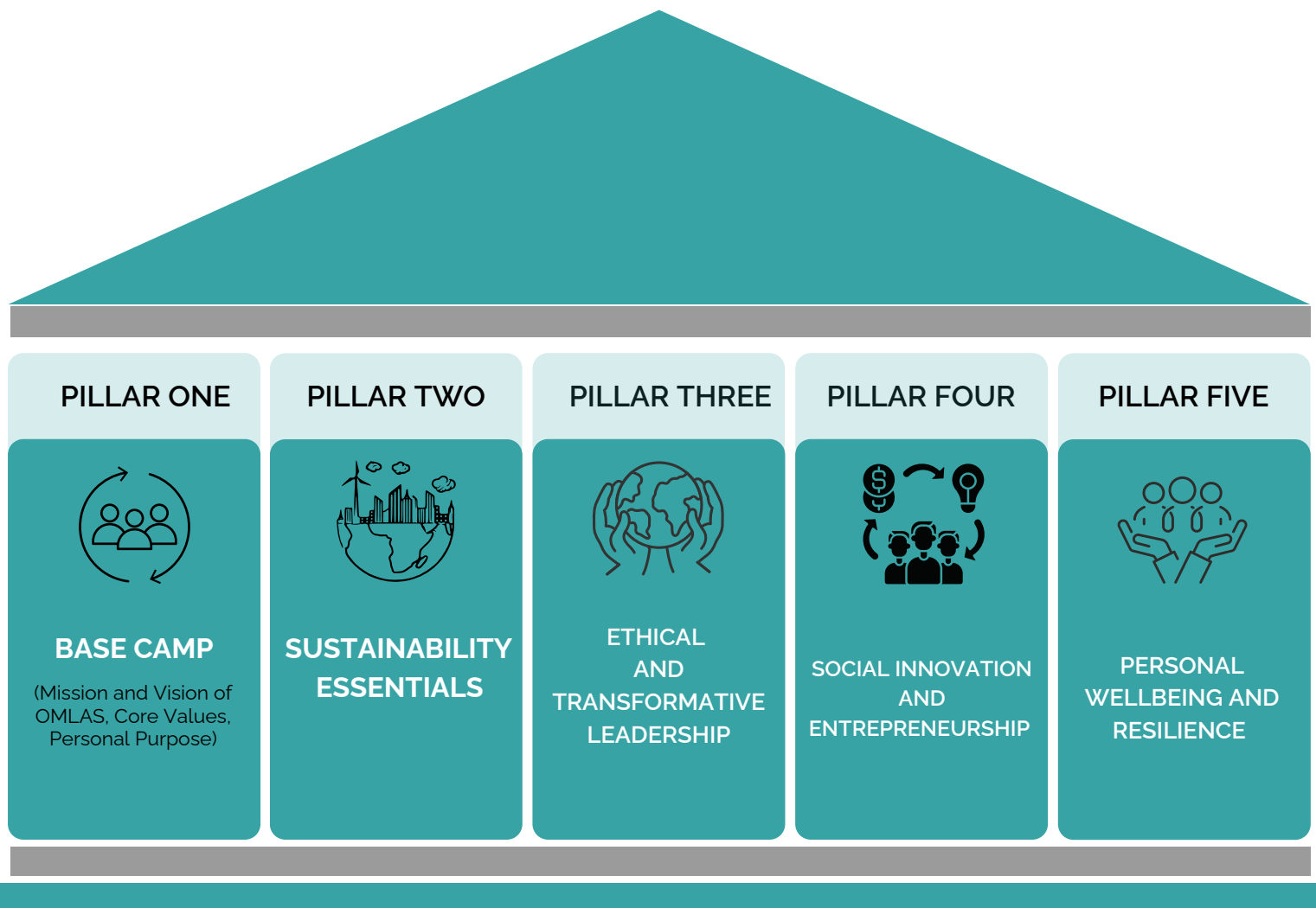
GRADUATION AND OML ALUMNI COMMUNITY

All Fellows and Champions who have successfully completed the Fellowship Program will graduate as OML leaders and join the global OML Alumni Community. They will help connect, inspire, and empower NexGen leaders around the world and gain access to the networking and empowerment opportunities provided in and through the Alumni Community.

OMLAS CURRICULUM PILLARS



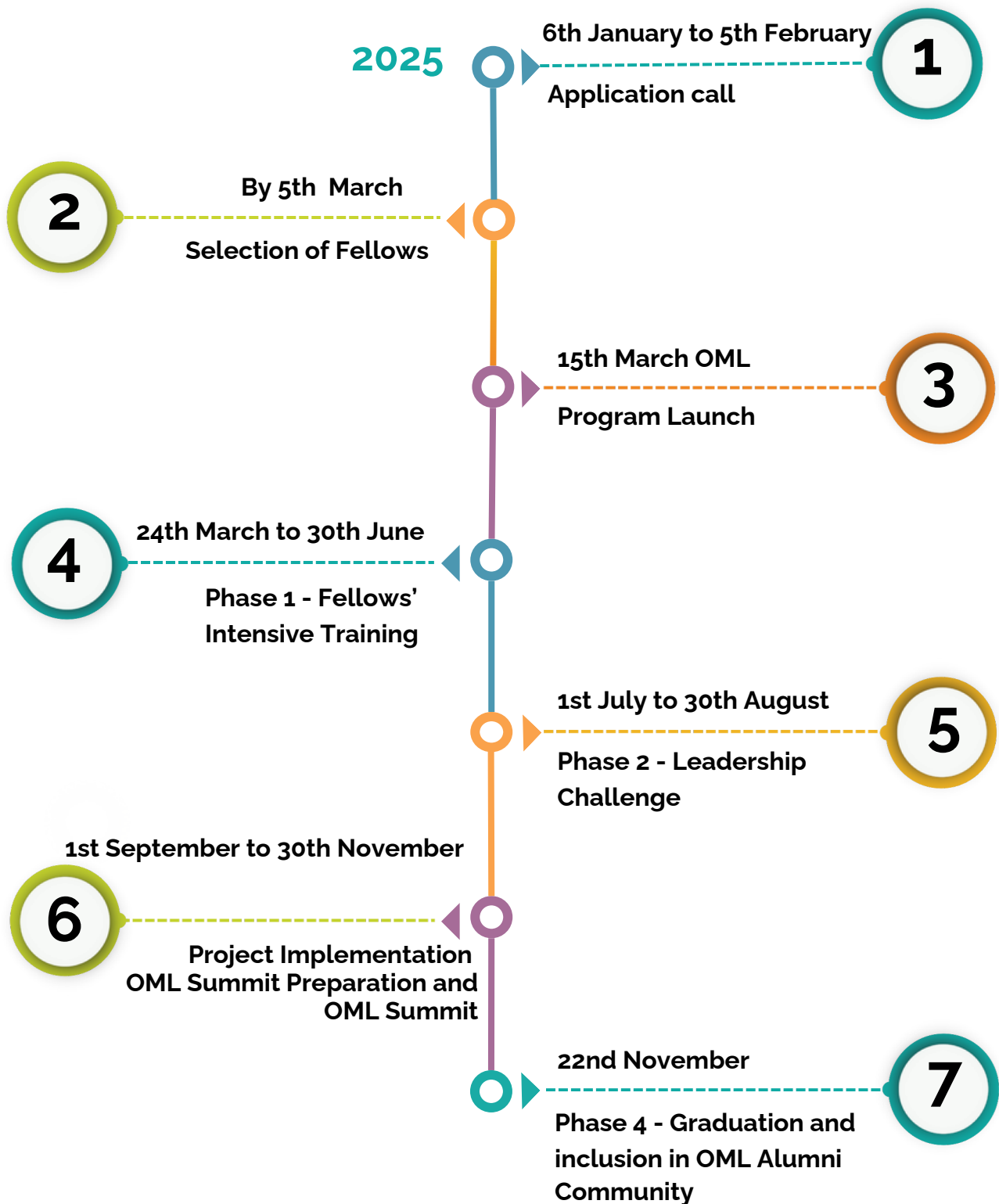
Five Curriculum Pillars of OMLAS Fellowship Program

OMLAS Fellowship Program Timeline

The OMLAS Fellowship Program begins in March 2025 and ends in November 2025 and runs in the four main phases mentioned above.



Who can apply?



Specific requirements for OMLAS Fellowship Applicants

1. Age:

Between 18 to 40 at the time of application.

2. Language:

English (be conversant).

3. Education:

Bachelor's degree running or above. Any academic background is acceptable.

4. Country:

Country of origin and country of residence should be same and from Asia Pacific during the Program (March to November).

WHAT TO EXPECT?



Training

Intensive online training (3 months) on the Five OML Curriculum Pillars. This will equip Fellows with skills, tools, and knowledge to lead and inspire positive change.



Opportunity to mentor young leaders

Opportunity to grow as a leader and mentor other NexGen sustainability leaders.



Opportunity to host and lead OML Summit

In October (17-19) 2025, NELIS Global and OMLAS Secretariat will host OML Summit(Virtual) and local physical summit. Fellows and Champions could lead and organize this global as well as local summit.



Local2Global Networking

The networking opportunities with leaders from all Asian countries is invaluable. It will provide long term engagement with leaders and change-makers in the Global Alumni Community.

The OMLAS Fellowship Program is entirely free of cost but not free from commitment . Selected young leaders will receive the intensive training program without any charges, but they need to empower young leaders in their countries and region. They need to commit for all four phases of the Program.

We embrace diversity and are dedicated to fostering an inclusive environment for all young leaders throughout Asia-Pacific region.

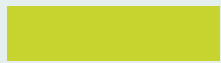
We enthusiastically encourage applications from individuals of all backgrounds and experiences.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS



Application

The application form must be duly filled in. All fields must be filled in unless there is an option.



Initial Screening

The application form will be reviewed. If all fields are duly filled in and the criteria match, applicants will be selected for the next stage.



Detailed Evaluation

The applications that pass the initial screening will go for detailed evaluation. All the initially screened applications will be evaluated against the same evaluation criteria. Applicants who pass this phase will be invited to an interview.



Interview

Selected candidates will be asked to participate in an online interview.

Final Selection

125 fellows will be selected for the 2025 cohort of the OMLAS Fellowship Program from Asia-Pacific region. Final selection and announcement will be made by **5th March** 2025 by the OMLAS Secretariat. Only short-listed applicants will be notified for an interview process.

OMLAS Fellowship Cascade Model

The OMLAS Fellowship Program is based on a unique cascading model that aims to connect and empower a large number of young leaders in each region, with two tiers of leaders – Fellows and Champions. As part of their Leadership Challenge, each of the 100 Fellows connect and empower at least 20 Champions (in Africa, 50) from their community or country.
